ENTRY. – CLOSING DATE – 6th APRIL 2026

All entries are to be completed online via the following website; www.blackpooldancefestival.com A confirmation of entry will be emailed to the email address given on the account. If Competitors do not receive a **Confirmation of Entry within seven days of the closing date** it is their responsibility to contact the organiser to verify that they are entered in the relevant Competitions.

JUDGING - For all Competitions the Board of Adjudicators will consist of members selected from the various Associations of Teachers of Dancing, together with any other Judges who may be appointed. Should any adjudicator suffer illness we reserve the right to replace at any time.

COMPETITORS' PRACTICE:

The Winter Gardens Empress Ballroom will be open for Competitors' Practice at certain times. Please see the Programme for details. Public and Competitors will be admitted on production of Daily or Season Ticket, without Extra Charge.

All Competitors wishing to enter the British Championships/Competitions **MUST** hold a valid licence with their Country of entry as an Amateur OR Professional.

Amateur/Professional: 16 years of age or over (one competitor must be over 16 years or over)

Over 35 Years: Both to be over 35 years of age on the day of the Competition. Proof of age may be required.

Over 50 Years: Both to be over 50 years of age on the day of the Competition. Proof of age may be required.

Under 19 Years: One competitor must be over 16 and both under 19 years of age on the day of the Competition. Proof of age may be required.

Under 21 Years: One competitor must be over 16 and both under 21 years of age on the day of the Competition. Proof of age may be required.

Formation: Open to teams of amateurs who are entered and coached by a Teacher who is a member of a recognised Association. British Teams **MUST** be registered, Non British Teams must hold a valid Registration with their Country of entry.

The role in which competitors commence the competition must be maintained throughout the event. No role changing during/mid dance. Anyone competing or spectating (any event) do so at their own risk.
